

MANAGING WORKERS WHO TEST POSITIVE FOR COVID-19



Worker with no symptoms

- Continue working as normal.
- Take precautionary measures. This can include:



Avoid gatherings



Wash and/or sanitize hands regularly



Wear a mask



Clean workstation

Note: Does not apply to staff in health facilities and care homes where isolation may be required.”

Worker with mild symptoms

- Isolate for 7 days from the start of symptoms.
- Take precautionary measures.
- Mild symptoms last only a few days and does not require hospitalization. They can include:



Cough



Fatigue



Fever



Headache



Sore throat



Worker with severe symptoms

- Isolate for 7 days from the date oxygen therapy is no longer required.
- Take precautionary measures.
- Severe refers to a person who is hospitalized or requires oxygen therapy or critically ill.



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
